















 - 88,967 tickets for December increase by 8%
 - December very busy compared to 2018
 - 2020 was a record year
 - i. 1.43 million tickets come in
 - ii. 10 million notices went out
 - iii. Up 1% from 2019
 - **We are only taking emergency tickets from 10pm to 6am**
 - Big push to iDig to reduce volume of calls coming into center

 - 10 question survey everyday























