### **3.) Presentation: Dig With Care, Build with Purpose by Steven Hill with United Ally Utility Services**

- Steve described damage prevention as a culture and that we need to empower our teams by communicating clearly and effectively and treat every dig as a unique opportunity to ensure safety and reliability.

### **4.) OHIO811 Updates**

- In November, there were 118,126 notifications made to the center, which is 7.11% above last year.
- Year to date, there have been 1,563,612 notifications made to the center which is up 6.77% above last year.
- Ohio House Bill 227 – passed the house, and it is in testimony now.
- OHIO811 will be switching software providers to Norfield's Dig Logix's.
- Paradigm meetings will be starting in Ohio on January 14<sup>th</sup>. The Cleveland area meeting is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at Todaro's Party Center in Akron (7am start time)
